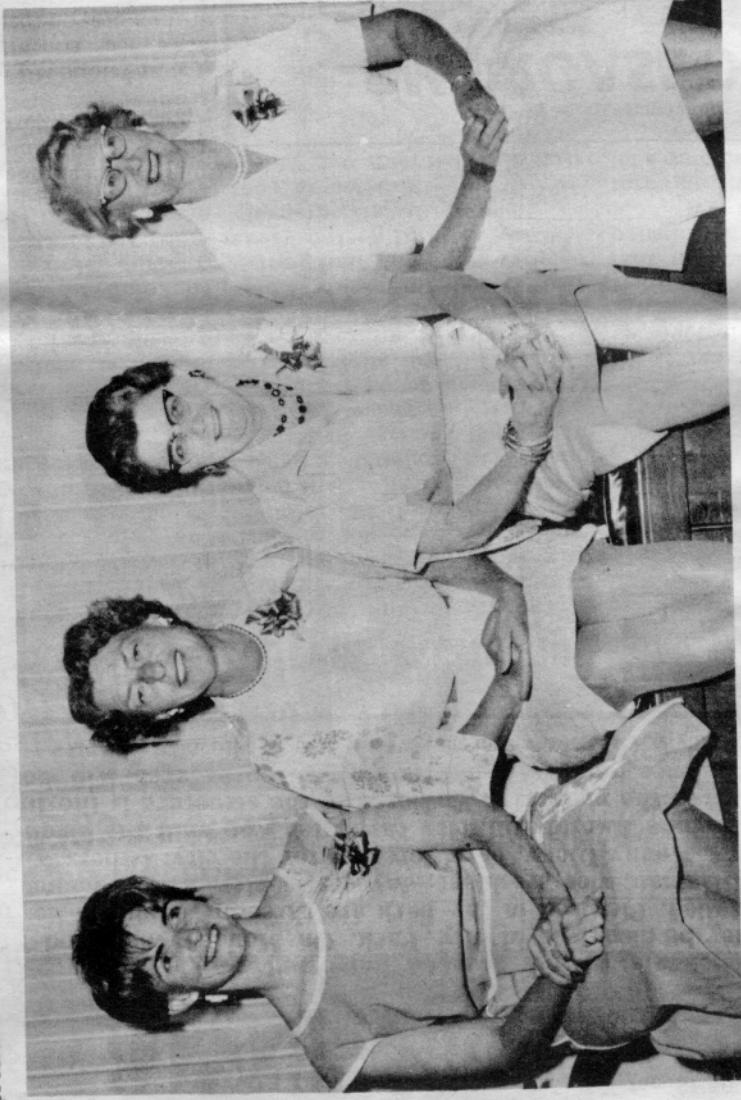

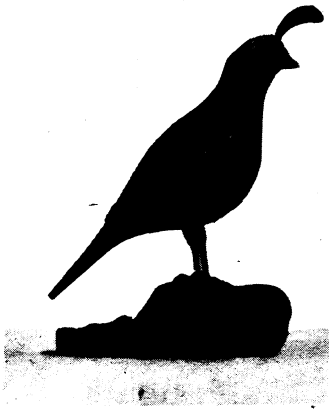

Famous singer Mary Ford, the Sons of the Pioneers, Charlie Pickett and the drum corps from St. John's Indian School are also scheduled for appearances.

A western costume contest will be judged by **Mr & Mrs Don McNerney** and **P. F. Keehn**. Awards will be made for cowboy, cowgirl, gunman, sheriff, miner and dance hall girl. Another contest which figures to be popular is **Desert Floral Arrangement**. It will be judged by **Mrs R. J. Daley**, **Mrs Carl Beillen** and **Mrs E. P. Cochran**.

The western atmosphere which is the theme for the get-together will get another boost with a rodeo to be presented by the **Junior Saddle Club** and the **Roping Club**.

One of the most spectacular parts of the program, to which everyone is invited, towns people and visitors, will be the **Saturday night dances**. Two orchestras from Phoenix will play, one for the square dance which will be on the parking lot between the **Post Office**, **Ray's Saddlery** and **Cinco J**. It will start at 7:30 and everyone is urged to wear western costume. At the same time the other orchestra will play for the round dance which will be on the **Shannan Frontier Market** parking lot. The dual dance program is in the hands of the **Centennial Committee**, **Don Cook**, **Herb Cameron** and **Rev. James Wilson**.

Gold panning which will take place at a special site on the grounds will be from **Friday morning** until **Monday afternoon**.

Church services will be held at the grounds for those who do not attend one of the **Wickenburg Churches**.

Wrap all this up with a hay-ride and weiner roast, flapjack flipping contest, a desert barbecue, desert breakfast ride, swimming and a few other things and you have the very busy program for the visiting folks.

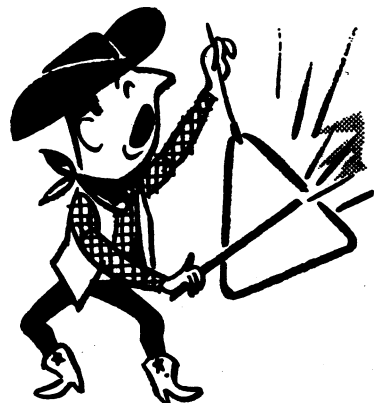
