Chillin' at Lahonton

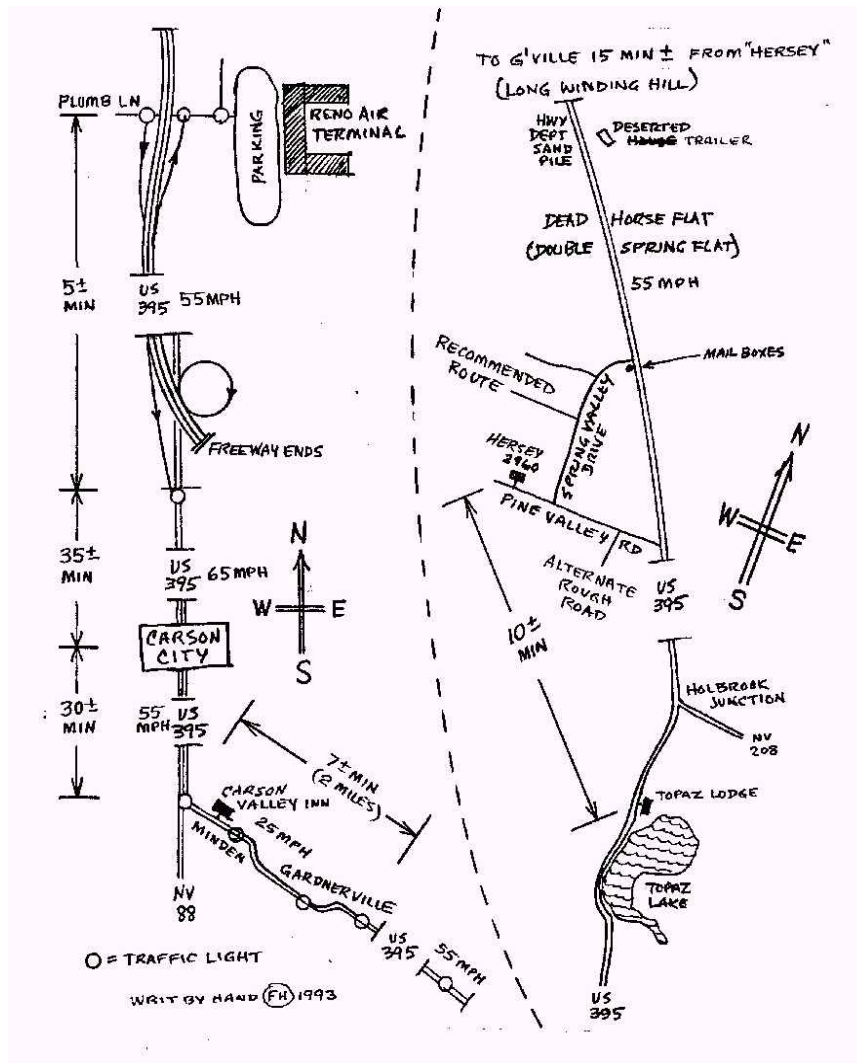
