# 2022 in Review

### PINE GROVE HISTORICAL SITE

The original Pine Grove Mine was discovered in 1866 by William Wilson. The Wheeler Mine was s'orred soon after and by 1868 there were two large mills and an errastra in operation by 1893 the Wilson Mine had produced \$5,000,000 and the Wheeler Mine \$3000,000. The original mostly gold with minor amounts of silver. There was reheved activity between 1900 and 1910 but the main strike was over. Except for some continued prospecting and occasional attempts to rework the tailings all activity had stopped by 1918.

As at neighboring Rockland, the first stage and freight road into the Town was a spur branching of the Wellington-Pine Grove Wagan Road over Kobdel and Pine Grove Summits and coming eastward down Store, Canvon, The present road from the east was not built u
