"In the Limelight"

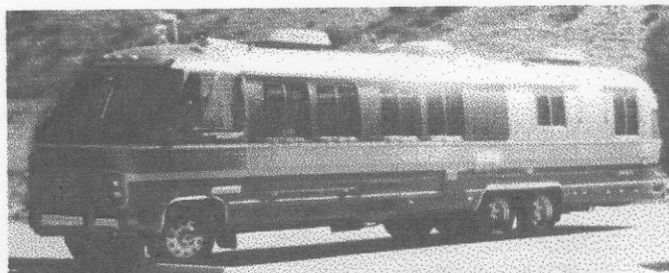


Keith and Dawn McGill

Could this be...the McGills??

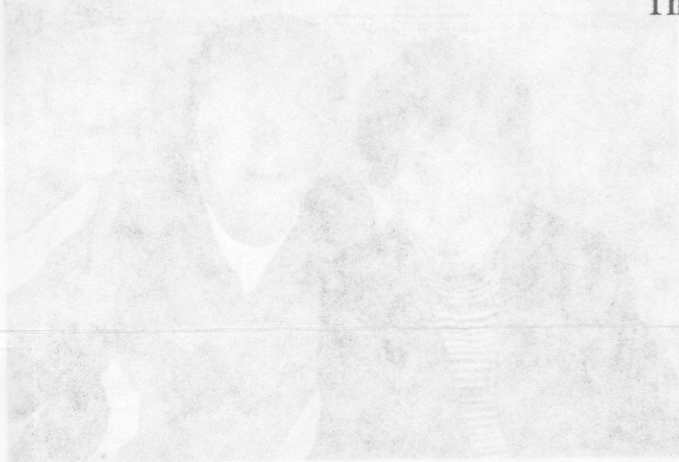

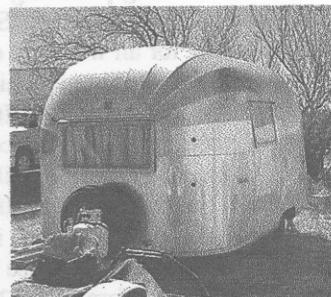
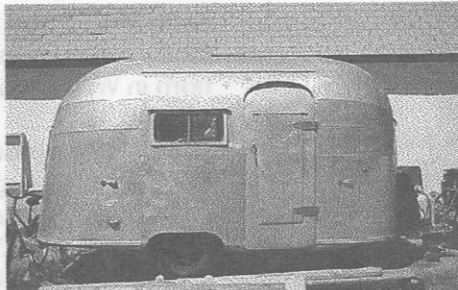
