Overview of SNU Rally Site Preferences

The SNU holds rallies monthly March through November. Our rally policy is that unless there are road restrictions in place on the travel day to the rally, the rally will take place. The types of rally sites SNU prefers include: open parking (like Lahonton Beach 7) or disbursed camping sites, sites that can accommodate eight or more rigs, sites that can accommodate any RV that qualifies for membership in WBCCI, and decent access roads. Roads may include good gravel or dirt. Grades over 5%, long grades, and sharp curves are not advisable. Roads should provide the ability to pull over and there must be a space to turn around. Using Reno as a starting point, travel distance to rallies should be within a two and a half hour drive of Reno.

Rallies should take into consideration the home base of our membership. Rallies should be planned in various locations throughout our region so that at least one rally a year will be as close as possible to the hometown of various members.
