Part 2 – Parking Fee (through the RV Park)

To reserve your site, you must call the Silver City Resort at 775-267-3359. Our group spaces have been prereserved but you need to call and reserve your specific site by <u>September 6, 2015</u>. Be sure to tell the park you are with the "Airstream Club."

RV Parking rates (rates are subject to change):

Passport America (PA) rates are good for your first four nights only:

- *PA Rate for first four nights is \$22.58 /night (incl. taxes)
- *PA Rate for fifth night is \$36.10/night (incl. taxes)
- *Total PA Members for all five nights: \$126.42 (incl. taxes)

RV Park discount rates (20% off regular rates): (for non-PA members)

RV Park Rate for per night is \$36.10 (incl. taxes)

Total non-PA-Rate for all five nights: \$180.50 (incl. taxes)

*PA rate is Passport America membership discount (50% off regular fee and costs \$44/yr) and **is good for the first four nights only.** To apply for PA go to <u>www.passportamerica.com</u>. For a reference enter Robert Stansbury #R-0232780 or any other PA member name and number. PA is accepted across the U.S.

LATE PARKING REGISTRATION (after 9/6/15) - you will need to contact Silver City Resort to make reservations (775-267-3359). Be sure to tell them you are with WBCCI Airstream Club. They will release our unused sites so it will be 1st come, 1st served. **Cancellation must be made no less than 30 days prior to your arrival**. Late cancellation charges: Deposit or first nights fee per reservation.
