Starting in November 2012, the SNU will no longer publish and distribute a print copy of the newsletter. The newsletter will be available in a PDF format on the SNU website. An 'opt-in' mailing list is used to announce the availability of most currently published newsletter as well as when there are time sensitive changes or updates related to rallies or other information pertinent to SNU members. The 'opt-in' mailing list ensures we are sending emails only to those who have subscribed (chosen) this option and not to those who do not wish to receive such emails. This system also enables subscribers to change their email address or unsubscribe at any time they choose. A second method is to use the RSS feed for the Zephyrs blog, <http://sierranevadaairstreams.org/snuze/> where newsletter posting announcements are made along with other RV and SNU related items. The third is to just keep an eye on the newsletter page of the SNU website to look for new issues online. The SNU is conscious of the proper use of personal email addresses. Email addresses provided to the SNU are used only for the SNU newsletter and announcements. They are not shared or made public in anyway.
